“CPR Saturday” Tiffany Circle Dinner: This event features Red Cross Health & Safety Demonstrations & Training. Tiffany Circle members and their guests will learn and practice both adult and infant CPR. This event takes place at a private Tiffany Circle members home in Cleveland.

Red Cross Hero Awards: Tiffany Circle members help honor a Red Cross youth hero by presenting her/him with a special Red Cross heroes award at a breakfast or luncheon event.

National Summit: Tiffany Circle members from throughout the nation convey in Washington D.C. for an inspirational Tiffany Circle Summit. This year’s summit will be held May 16 and 17 at the Mandarin Hotel. Highlights of the two day gathering include private Tiffany events at exclusive Washington D.C. locations, nationally renowned guest speakers, a presentation of Tiffany & Co. commemorative bracelets and charms in front of the historically significant Tiffany windows, which are located in the Board of Governor’s Hall at the American Red Cross National Headquarters.

Tiffany Tea: This year’s Tiffany Tea will include a complimentary design class, featuring Cleveland’s leading interior designers from Reflections Interior Design. Tiffany Members and their guests will be asked to bring a new blanket, which will be distributed to local families needing emergency assistance.

Healthy, Wealthy & Wise: A Tiffany Circle members and Circle of Friends - Women’s Wellness event. Featured guest speakers include health & safety experts and financial planning leaders in the field. The theme of this event is to teach women how to help keep themselves and their families safe, secure and self sufficient.

Red Cross Fire Safety Month: Tiffany Circle members gather for a fire safety walk to help distribute smoke detectors to families who reside in at-risk neighborhoods throughout Cleveland. Tiffany Circle members partner with the Cleveland Fire Department and Red Cross Emergency Services staff members for the October Fire Safety walk. This special program, unique to the Cleveland Red Cross, is called Operation Save-a-Life. To date the Greater Cleveland Red Cross has distributed and installed over 130,000 free smoke alarms in the City of Cleveland and surrounding communities, helping to keep our local families safe and secure
